



Aerial Edge's Youth Show is once again programmed in to Merchant City Festival!

Rosie Rodman-Orr is on board to direct our Merchant City Festival 2018 show!

Background

Since 2014 Aerial Edge have been working with Merchant City Festival to integrate circus as part of their annual celebrations, we've held shows in the 1873 hall of the Briggait, provided free circus taster sessions and in 2017 held our first youth show in Merchant Square.

2018 sees the UK celebrate 250 years of circus, sees Scotland celebrate Year of the Young people and sees Glasgow host the European Championships alongside Berlin!

This is an exciting year to be part of circus, and we're delighted to have our youth show once again programmed into the Merchant City Festival celebrations! The show will take place on Glasgow Green in a big top tent!

Auditions: Saturday 2nd June: 2 - 3pm

For the audition we ask students to show us a small sequence of moves, which demonstrates what you can do in your chosen discipline, whether that's something in the air or something on the ground, we welcome all talents from acting and music to aerial and acrobatics.

About the director:

Rosie Rodman-Orr is a graduate of the BA(Hons) in Contemporary Circus and Physical Performance, specialising in Aerial Silks. She went on to complete a Master's Degree in Theatre for Young Audiences at Bath Spa University, graduating in February 2017. As part of her degree programmes, she has created and participated in multiple aerial shows for all ages.



Since moving back to Scotland last year, Rosie has created work for the Edinburgh International Festival of Children's Theatre and the Scottish National Gallery of Modern Art, as well as working with Platform's Play Café, and as an emergent bursary artist with the Starcatcher's Expecting Something Project.

She currently teaches for High Jinx, Aerial Arthouse and Aerial Edge, as well as performing circus at family events around the UK.
