## Course Terms & Conditions

We look forward to welcoming you on to the Aerial Edge Foundation Course.

It is important that you understand the following Terms & Conditions, which you must agree to and adhere to.

### Attendance

To get the most out of the Foundation Course and to pass the Course, we expect 95% attendance rate. If you are planning to be absent from a class or for a specific day, please arrange this in advance. Many activities are group-based so they need everyone's attendance to go ahead.

### Payment of fees

Course fees are payable in advance according to the payment schedule, either in full in advance or in three instalments:

1. £200 deposit to be paid when you return the acceptance letter.
2. £1300 to be paid before the start of the Course.
3. £1499 to be paid before week 9 of the Course.

The instalment payment plan is not a plan that allows you to opt out at week 9. When you have signed the acceptance letter and started the Course, full payment is expected regardless of your attendance. Refunds will not be given unless there are exceptional circumstances.

### Training at Aerial Edge

All participants shall be entirely responsible for their health and physical capacity to take part in the classes and for their safety, by conducting themselves in a safe and responsible manner in the space.

Circus training incorporates a number of physical styles of movement, including running, jumping, vaulting, swinging, hanging, and climbing. Dangerous and unplanned movement is discouraged. We focus on training students to have good core strength, balance, and technique before being introduced to any movement that may involve risk.

Please note: Physical contact with an instructor may be necessary to support students, prevent accidents and to demonstrate moves relating to the tuition. Instructors are trained how to do this in appropriate ways, with minimal contact. We understand that some students may have concerns about this and if this is the case, we need to discuss this to ensure that instructors are aware and everyone concerned has an appropriate level of comfort about how to proceed.

### Your responsibilities

Please provide details of any relevant conditions, e.g., injury, disability, or medication, that may affect your participation in the Course classes. If you are unsure about your ability to take part, please consult a GP before signing up for this Course or any classes on the Course.

To ensure all participants' safety in our classes, it is your responsibility to comply with the rules on Page 2 of this document.

### Please Do:

- Arrive on time to your classes.
- Warm up properly before training. You may not be allowed to participate if you arrive too late for the warm-up.
- Inform your instructor of any injuries or medical conditions.
- Follow the teachers' instructions at all times.
- Use appropriate mats/ crash mats/safety equipment at all times during training.
- Cover any open wounds and notify a teacher immediately of all injuries and any blood on equipment.
- Be aware of your environment. Take care around uneven flooring and rigging wires.
- Let us know if you are having any problems during your class.
- If you are taking any photos or videos while in the space, please ensure you only film or photograph people who have given you permission.

### Please Do Not:

- Attend class when you are ill or if you have tested positive for COVID 19.
- Get on the equipment outwith class times or without instruction to do so.
- Distract teachers or other students.
- Stand or move under aerial equipment while others are on the apparatus.
- Attempt to teach other participants.
- Attempt to climb on the rig unless explicitly instructed to do so.
- Attempt to rig equipment or change any of the rigging in the space. Ask an instructor to get equipment out for you.
- Bring any nuts into the space, as we have students with severe allergies.

Any participant causing disruption or acting in an unsafe manner may be excluded without a refund from the class. Persistent disruptive or unsafe behaviour may result in exclusion from the remainder of the Course.

Aerial Edge may take photographs and videos of activities in the space to use for publicity. Aerial Edge may use your image for promotional purposes.

By agreeing to this policy, I declare that I have voluntarily read, understood, and accepted all the Code of Conduct & Risks matters, including all the risks, responsibilities, and obligations to which it refers.
